

## One Objection

### There's not enough proof for the Christian faith



#### Overview of the message:

First Chris looked at the concept of 'proof'. Proving that something is true can be difficult, but most of the time we will make a judgement based on the evidence available (e.g. the jury in a court of law).

Then Chris presented three different kinds of evidence:

- Philosophical evidence for the existence of God
- Scientific evidence for the existence of God
- Historical evidence for the Christian faith

#### Questions

1. Has anyone had experience discussing this objection with non-Christians before?
2. In small groups – what convinced you of the truth of Christianity when you became a Christian, and what gives you confidence day to day that it's true?
3. In small groups - how would you now respond to someone who said they couldn't believe in God/Christianity because they don't think there's enough proof?
4. (Extra question if you have time) Recap the historical evidence for Jesus:
  - Jesus' claims – he claimed to be God
  - Jesus' teaching – unsurpassed
  - Jesus' miracles
  - Jesus' character – people lived with him for years and still believed he was God
  - Prophecies about Jesus' life – from the Old Testament
  - Jesus' resurrectionWhich of these stand out to you/are particularly compelling?
