

## Worship Matters – Worshipping God in all Circumstances



For the last sermon in our worship series, Faith talked about the importance and power of worshipping God whilst we are in difficult circumstances. She looked at the example of Jehoshaphat and the Israelites in 2 Chronicles 20:1-30. Often when we face difficulties, we try to solve them ourselves, or carry them around as burdens, rather than looking to God for the solution.

Worshipping God can seem foolish/weak in the face of difficult challenges, but actually that is where true power lies. Jehoshaphat put the singers at the front of the army, and when they started singing, God fought and destroyed the Israelites' enemies. God often brings breakthrough when we turn to Him and choose to worship Him in the face of difficulties.

### Questions

Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-30.

1. What's your default response when you encounter difficulties in life?
2. Do you find it hard to choose to worship God through tough situations? What makes it difficult?
3. When we worship together, do you view it as a powerful weapon in the spiritual battle we're part of?
4. Do you have any testimonies of seeing God come through for you when you chose to worship Him in a difficult situation?
5. Faith talked about reminding herself each day "I am blessed and highly favoured". How does this fit in with worshipping God through difficult times? Is this something you do, or could it be helpful for you?
